1) Traineeship institution

Please give a brief description of your host traineeship insitution.

ADRA-Bosnia is completely dedicated to the fight for social justice, which concretely means easing the suffering of the poor, fighting for the rejected and oppressed, and being a voice of the voiceless. Since 1992 they have extended their activities to other regions in Bosnia. The organization has two offices, one in Sarajevo and another in Banja Luka. The working team is made up of 9 personnel ; 2 workers in Sarajevo and 7 in Banja Luka with 3 of them being full-time workers while the other 4 are part-time employees. Hence, the Organizational structure and Management of ADRA Bosnia is vertical. It is comprised of the country director, the project manager who works in a double capacity as the administrative assistant and media director and lastly the employees.

As of recent, ADRA-Bosnia is focusing on social entrepreneurship which is to create jobs and make people be independent and learn to fish on their own while learning skills and not solely depending on humanitarian aid.

2) Searching for a traineeship

How did you find your traineeship? Are there any recommendable links or other helpful tips you would like to share?

During my last semester, in which I had to go for an internship as part of my study program the covid pandemic disturbed my academic schedule. I had to hault for awhile while searching for possible internship opportunities abroad. It was during this period that my lecturer sent an email about an internship opportunity with ADRA Bosnia, precisely in Banja Luka, that can be sponsored by Erasmus.

My state of mind was already prepared for possible cultural shocks and other challenges such as language barrier. However, due to several exchanges with my trainee suppervisor via emails and advice from other students who did their internship, it was easier for me to to prepare in advance so as to intergrate into the new area. During my internship at ADRA Bosnia in Banja Luka, I performed tasks such as, collecting data for potential clients networking, and helping women in the programme to produce marketable goods. I worked together with other institutions in the wide network of ADRA Bosnia like "Friendship of Mozaik". At "Friendship of Mozaik" helped in preparing ingredients to cook food for the elderly and less privileged ones. I also helped in sorting out donations to be distributed to them on a specific day

At the reception, I was told with my student visa I can stay in Bosnia for 90 days. Though I insisted of having the visa, they told me to ask for a letter from the host institution which I did. However, upon arrival in Bosnia airport, I was informed that I can not stay continuously more than a month in Bosnia. Thus, I needed to move to the bordering countries of Bosnia territory every month before re-entry which was time-wasting and financially costly.

Yes, students should endeavor to have their visa, before traveling no matter what the embassy tells them.

To conclude, It was amazing working in a country that its cultural diversity to similar to mine (although the two countires are so far apart from each other). Moreover, I was ready to learn and work hard to achieve my internship goals in Bosnia.
